Hydrological data base, using GIS platform, is developed for usage of Groundwater Management Committees, covering 636 habitations.

About 6,500 farm families enabled for adoption of alternative agricultural practices suiting the availability of groundwater.

Community based institutions established for alternative management of groundwater resources with equal representation/ participation of men and women.
